




Colpocephaly. Prominent cisternamagna.

Hypo plastic cerebellum.

Fetal skull normal in shape.

Fetal neck appear normal.

Heart is normal in situs.

Four chamber view is normal.

Note: All cardiac anomaly cannot be detected with FCV.

Suggested detailed cardiac study in high risk patients.

No intrathoracic mass lesions.
